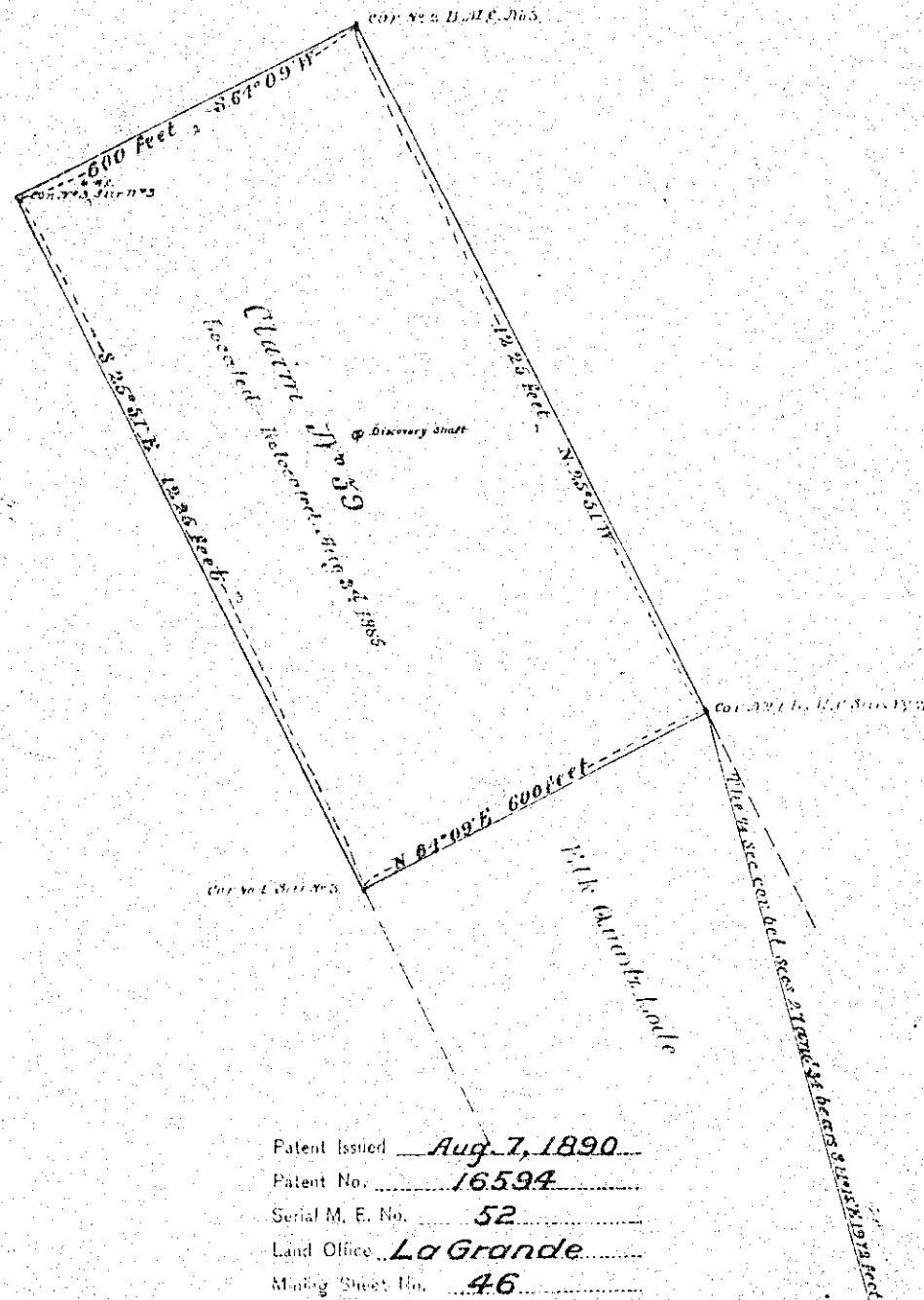


1-2 is 2, 30° 52' 30" N. 100.50 feet
