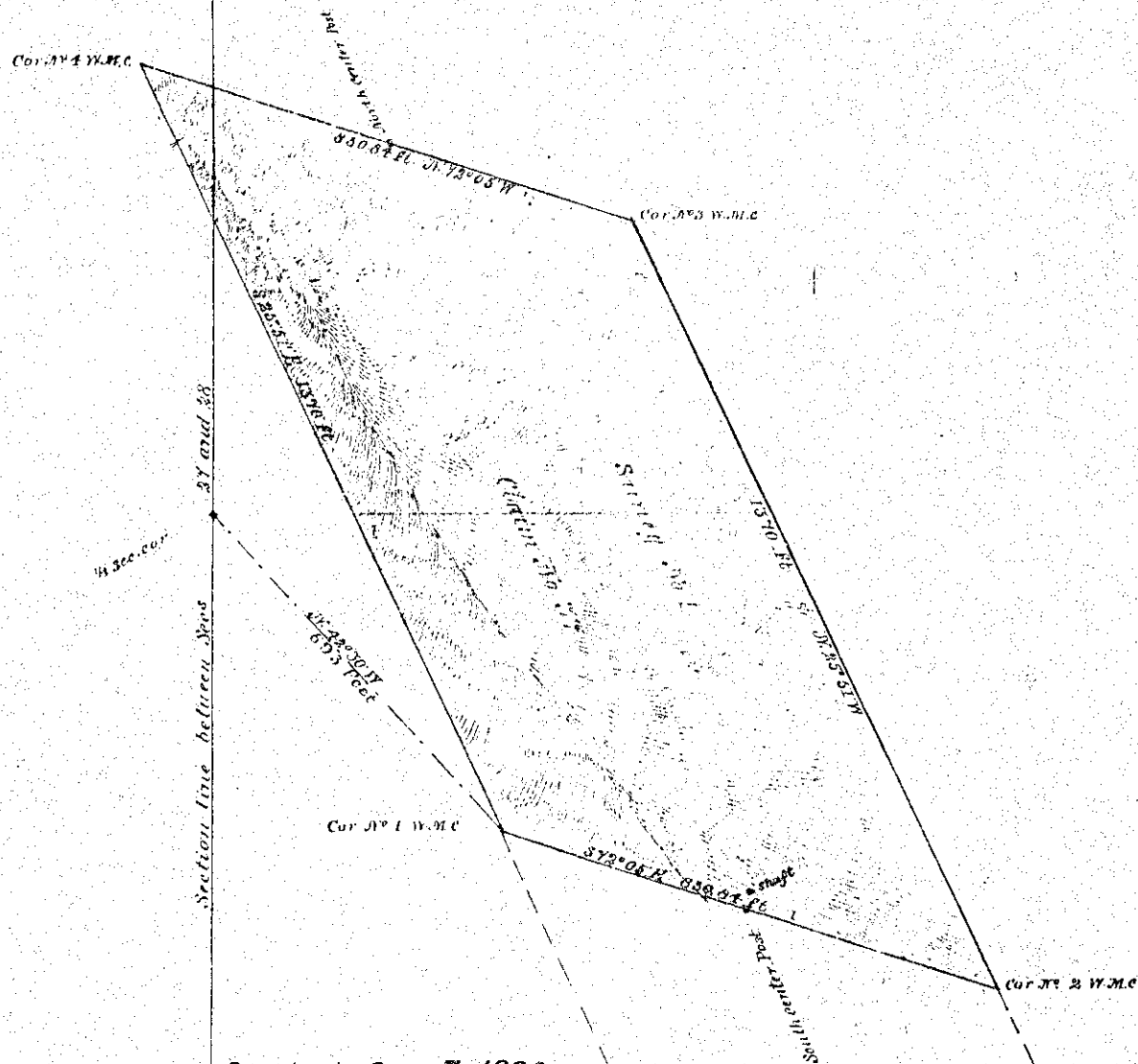


Line 1-2 is S. 74° 05' E. 231.14 ft.
