

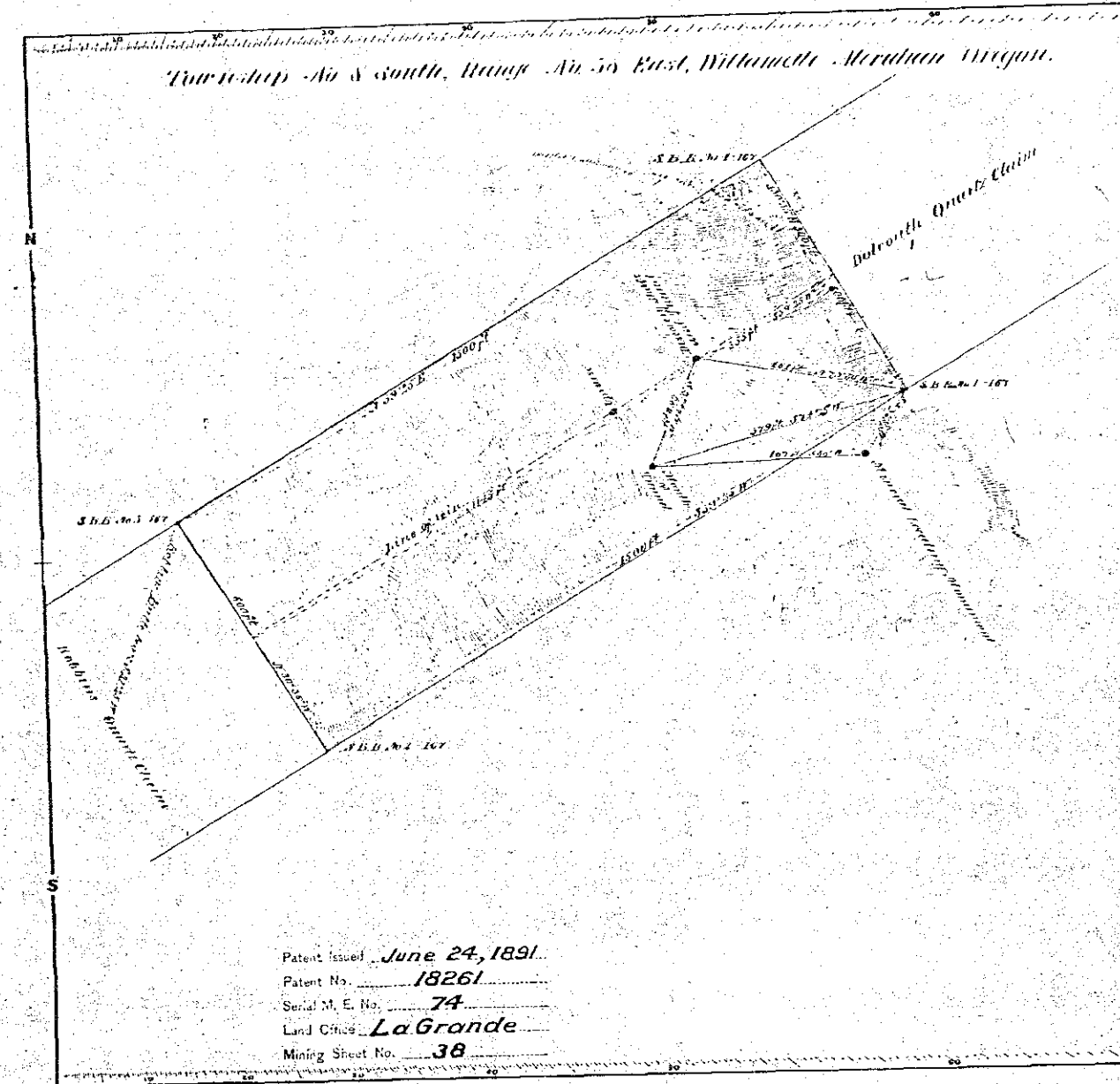

I further certify that five hundred dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant or his grantors, and that said improvements consist of 115 ft of tunnels made in solid rock, and 105 ft of shaft and repairs.
