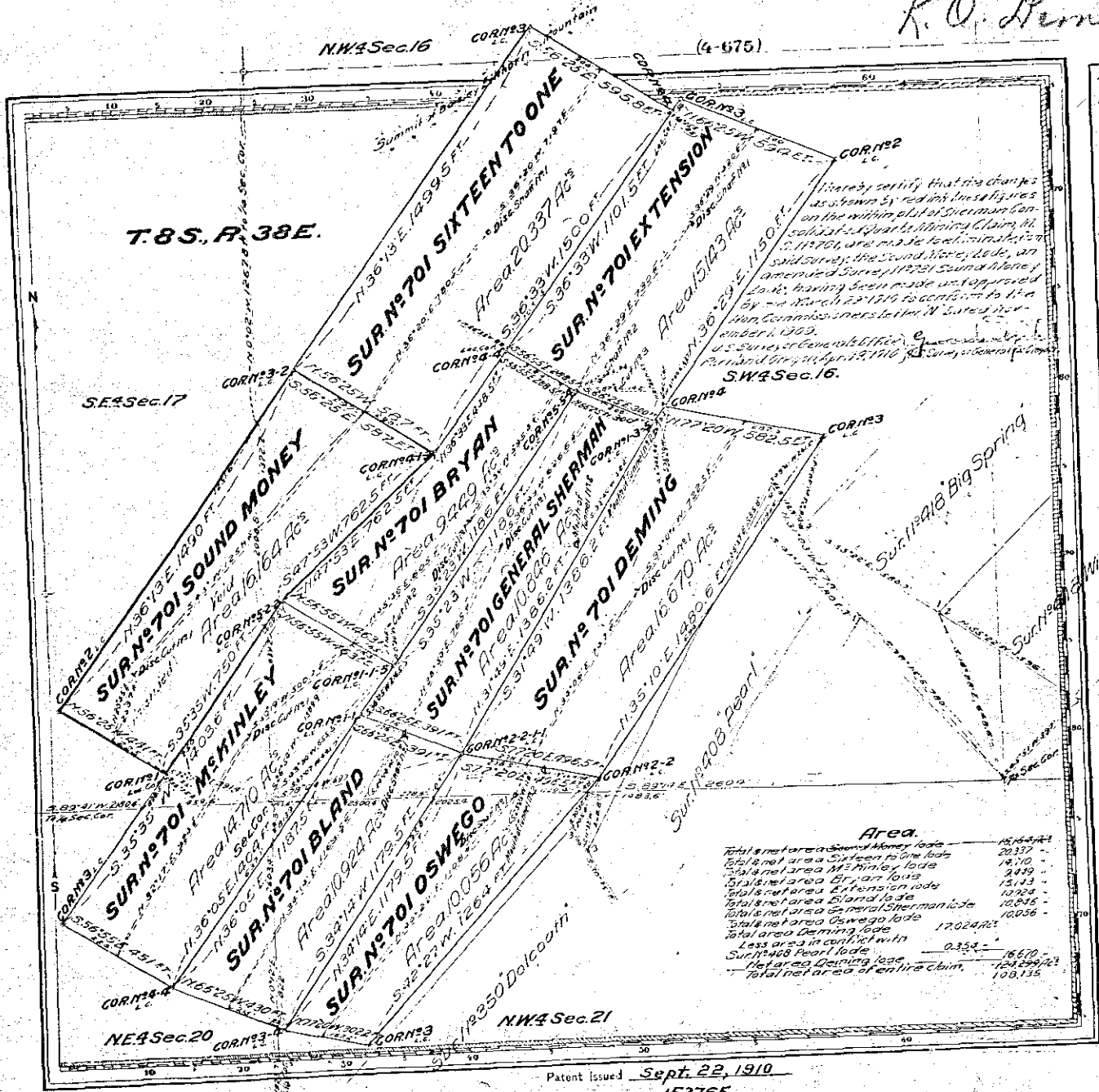

I further certify that five hundred dollars worth of labor has been expended on improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant or his grantors, and that said improvements consist of 20 ft. of cuts, 18 ft. of 39 ft. of shafts, value, \$1,200; 1200 ft. of tunnel, value, \$19,728.33; total value, \$20,928.33.
