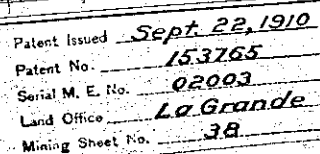

I further certify that five hundred dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant — or his grantors, and that said improvements consist of 156,360 ft. of labor = \$25.50 One fifth interest in tunnel No. 2 General Sherman Lode, Sec. 10, 704, comprising 422 ft. of main tunnel and 1512 ft. of branches, total 1936 ft. of tunnel & branches = \$320.00, that the location of said improvements is correctly shown upon this plat, and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim.
