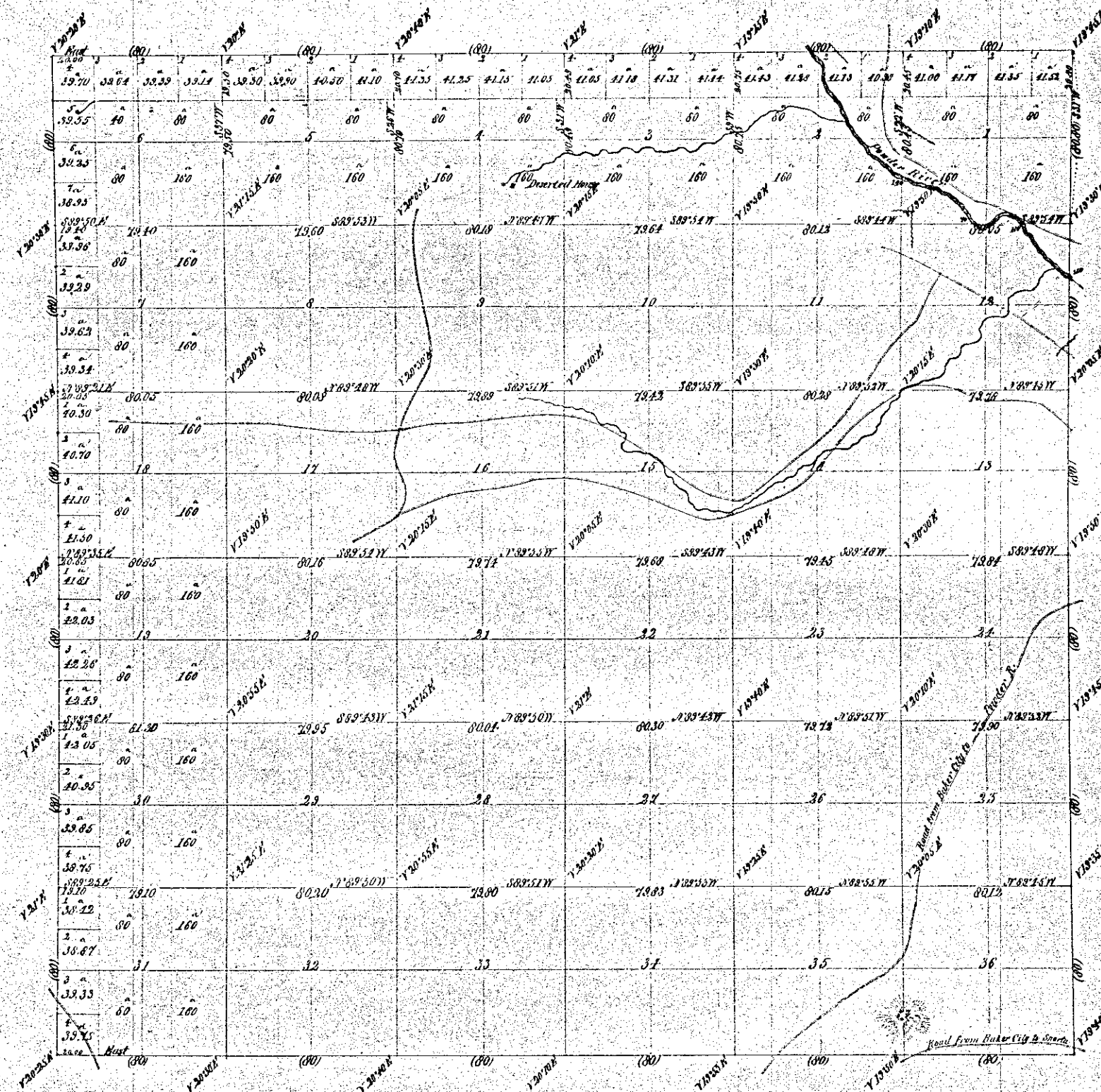

General Description
 The land in this Township with the exception of portions of sections 1, 3, 11 and 23, and certain portions of sec. 4 may be classed as 3rd rate. It formerly is covered with excellent bunch grass. There are no springs or water in the Township excepting two small brooklets shown on the Diagram. The Township forms the divide between Upper and Lower Powder river and may be called a spur extending north. It has timbering for an extensive cattle range for the ranches scattered along Lower Powder River.
