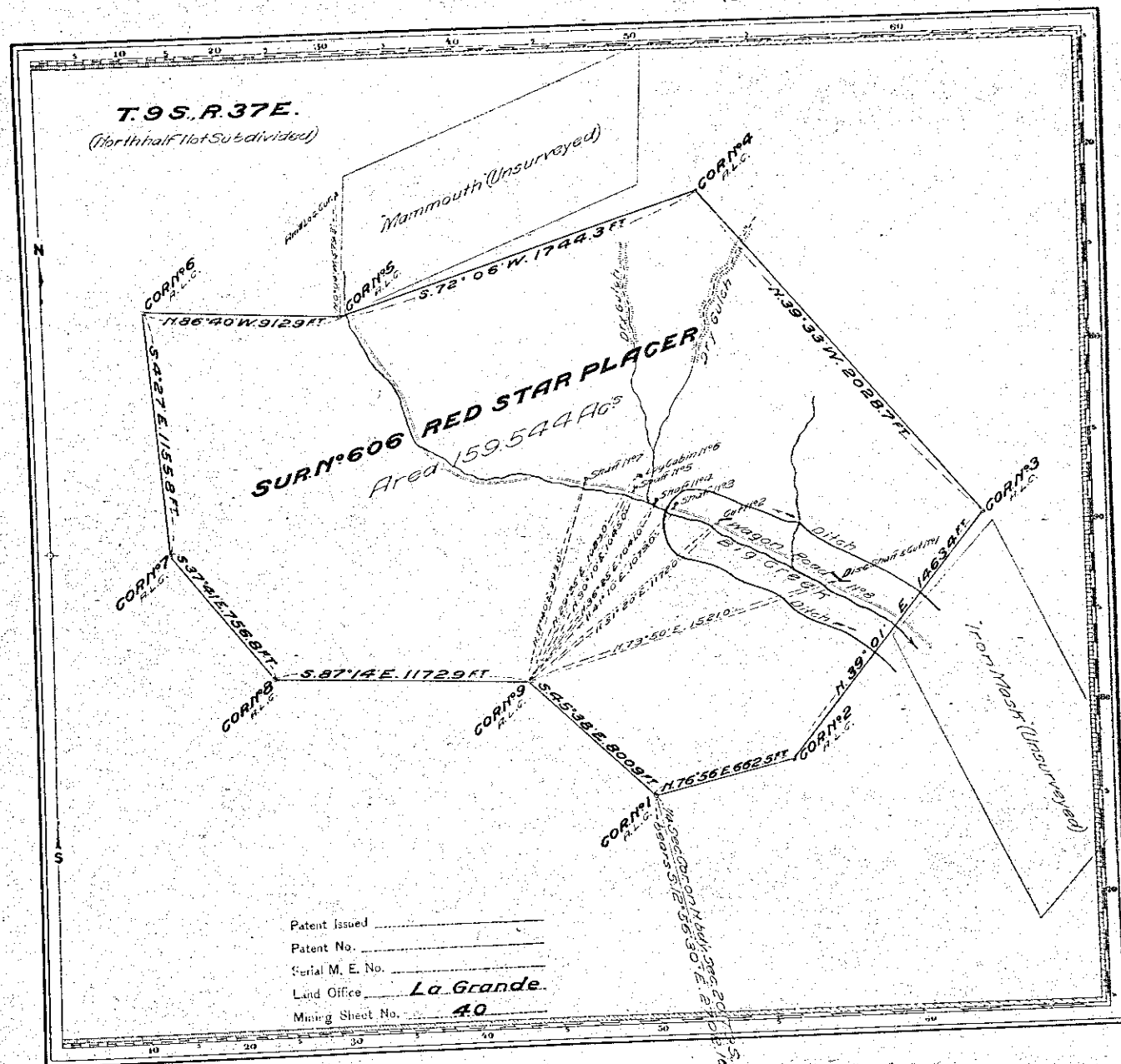

from which this plat has been made under my direction, & have been examined and approved, and are on file in this Office; and I hereby certify that they furnish such an accurate description of said Mining Claim as will, if incorporated into a patent, serve fully to identify the premises, and that such reference is made thereto to natural objects or permanent monuments as will perpetuate and fix the locus thereof.

I further certify that Five Hundred Dollars, worth of labor has been expended on improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant — or his grantors, and that said improvements consist of 474 ft of Shaft, 102 ft of Cut, Value, = 75%; 58 ft of Cut, Value, = 40%; 28 ft of Shaft, Value, 85%; 100 ft Log Cabin, Value, = 60%; 5200 ft of Hoop Road, = 300%; 5 ft of 1/2 56 ft; and that the location of said improvements is clearly shown upon this plat, and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim.

And I further certify that this is a correct plat of said Mining Claim made in conformity with said original field notes of the same, &c., and the same is hereby approved.
