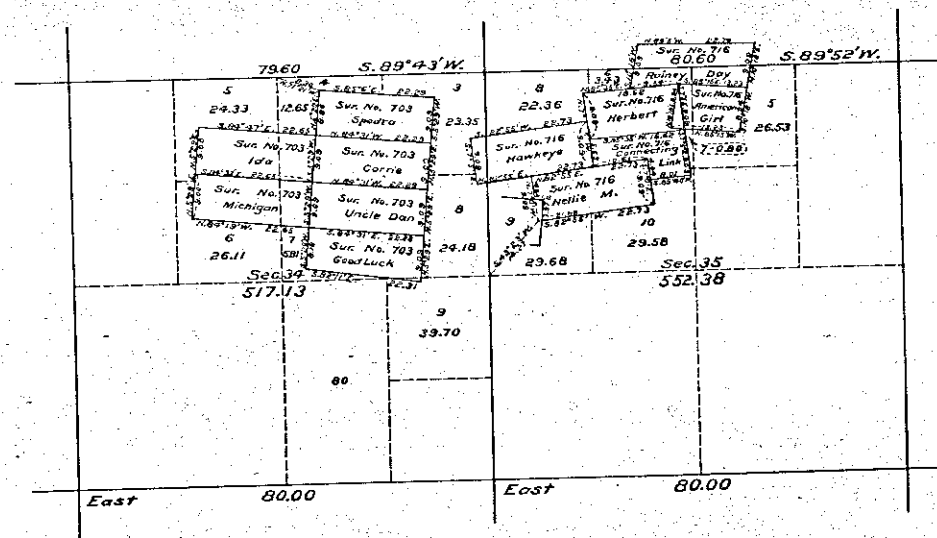


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Amended Plat of Sections 34 and 35 — T.9 S. R.41 E. of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon. (Superseding lottings in said sections, shown on plat approved Dec. 18, 1901) Scale 20 chains to an inch.

M.R. 285, La Grande series, based upon Mineral Survey 445, canceled by letter N. of December 12, 1908. The segregation of Survey 445 shown upon a amended plat of December 18, 1901 is therefore without effect.

The record in M.E. 07441, Survey 716 for the Herbert Consolidated Group of lode claims, shows that the conflict of 0.525 acres with unsurveyed Carinne lode is excluded from the Nellie M. lode claim of said group and that the area of said Nellie M. lode as patented is 20.135 acres.

This amended plat of Sections 34 and 35, T.9 S. R.41 E. of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, is made for the purpose of showing the segregation of patented Mineral Survey 703 and patented portion of Mineral Survey 716 with resulting lottings and areas; prepared in compliance with instructions from the Hon. Asst. Commissioner of the General Land Office contained in letter N. (CAN) dated April 6, 1917, in order to accommodate Homestead Application La Grande 016717 of John H. Bagley.
