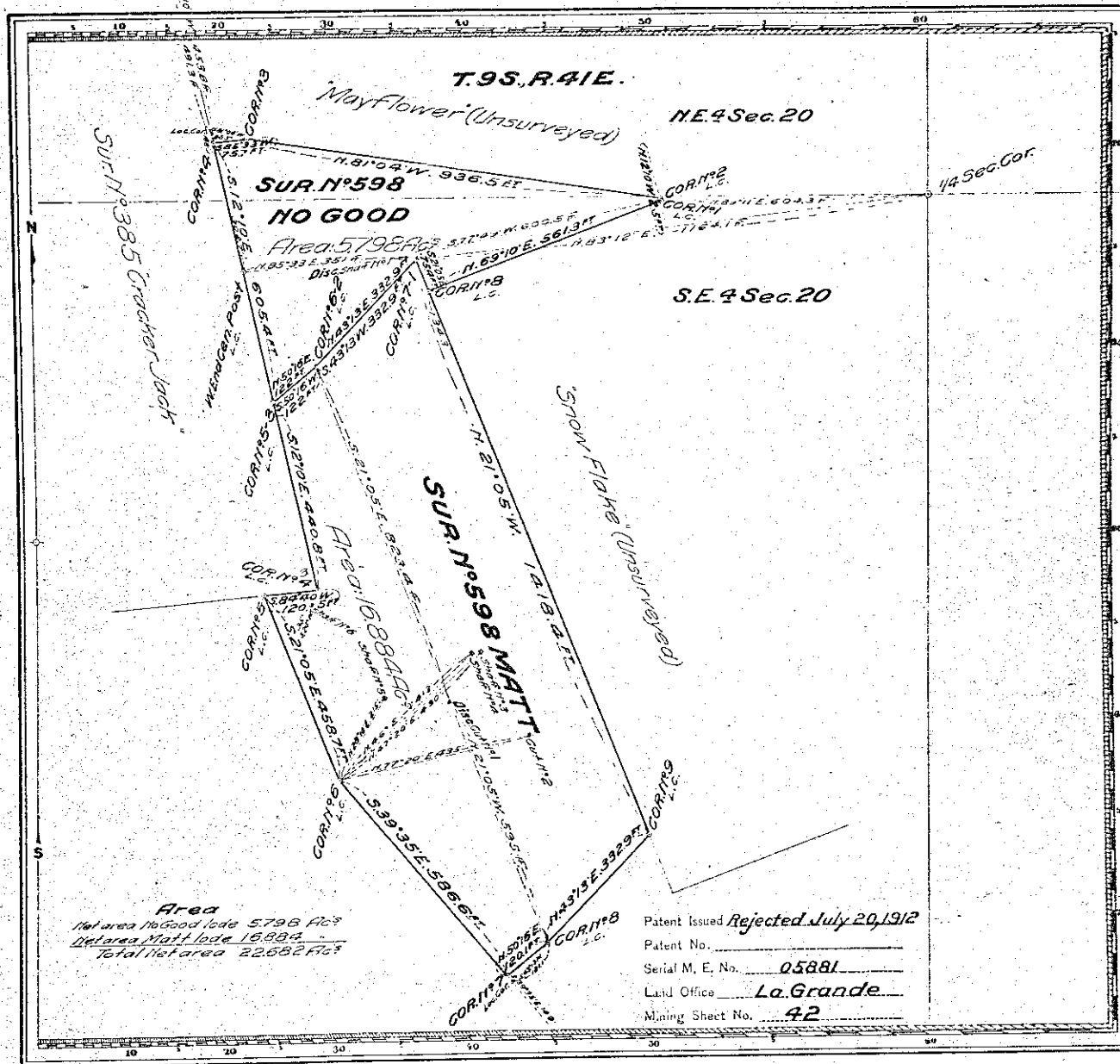

I further certify that Five Hundred Dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant or its grantors, and that said improvements consist of 25 ft. of shaft, value \$505.27 ft. of crosscut, value \$50.23, interest in No. 530 ft. of crosscut tunnel branch on Sur. N°597, value \$350.23, interest in Power House, Electric line & Flagon Road on Sur. N°597, value \$143.33, that the location of said improvements is correctly shown upon this plat, and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim.
