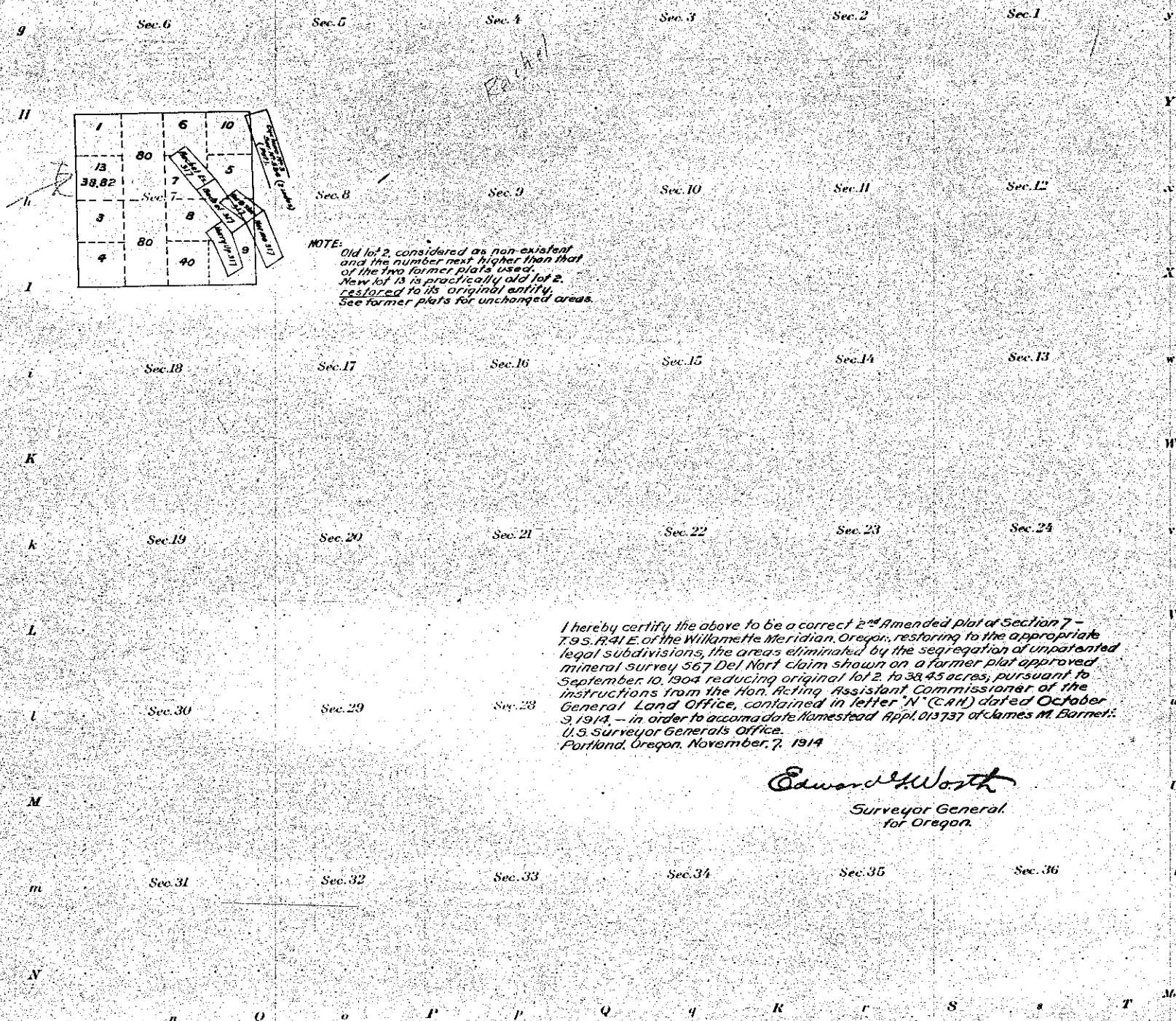


2nd Amended Plat of Section 7
