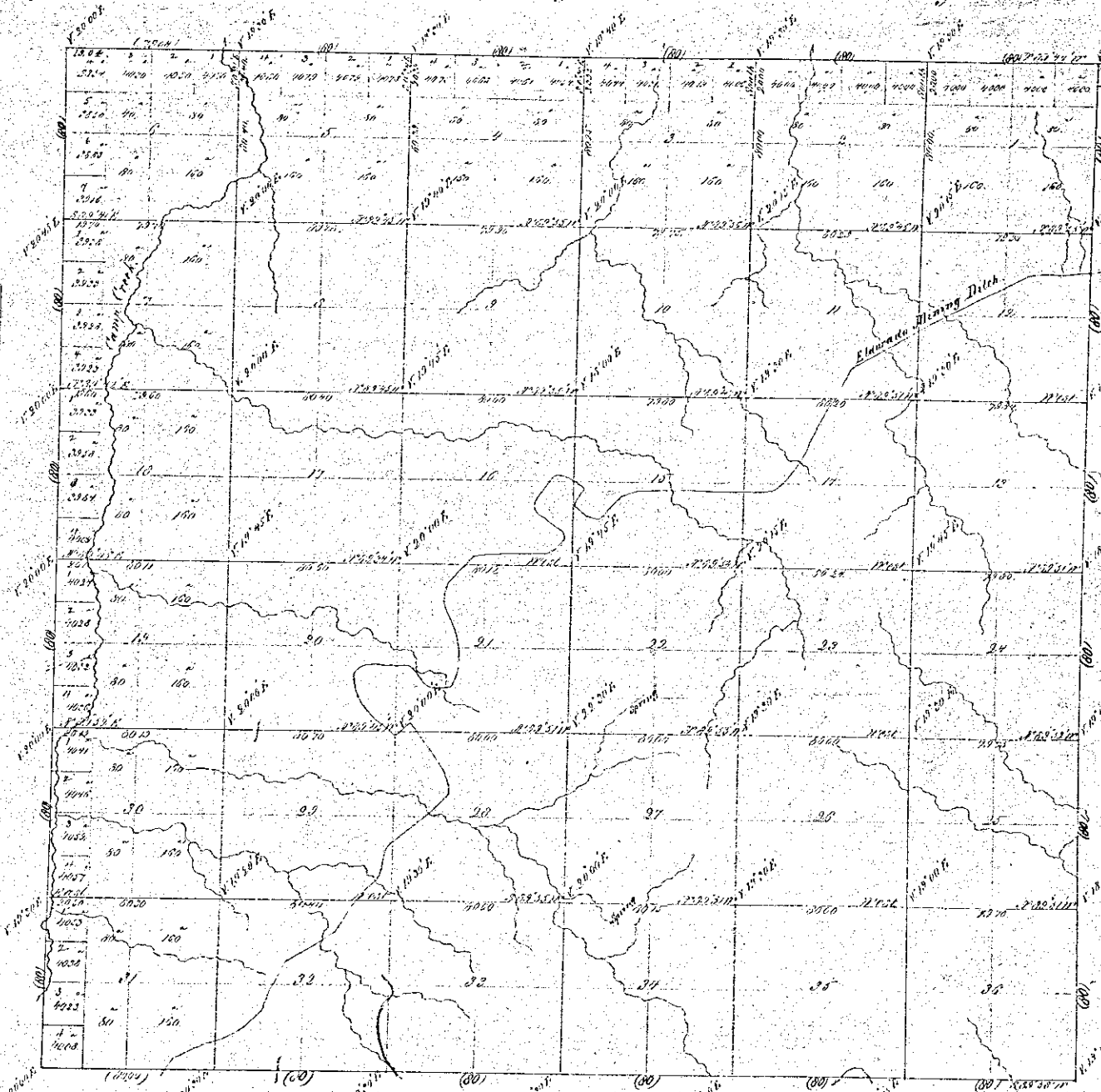

General Description.

The land in this Township consists generally of rolling hills of 25 feet quality of soil, which are covered with a good but growth of brush, grass affording excellent facilities for stock raising. The Township is well watered by Camp Creek in the Western part, in which there are some good & headlands, also by several smaller Brooks in the Eastern part. The Elmer Mining ditch carrying about 500 inches of water runs through the Township from S.W. to N.E.
