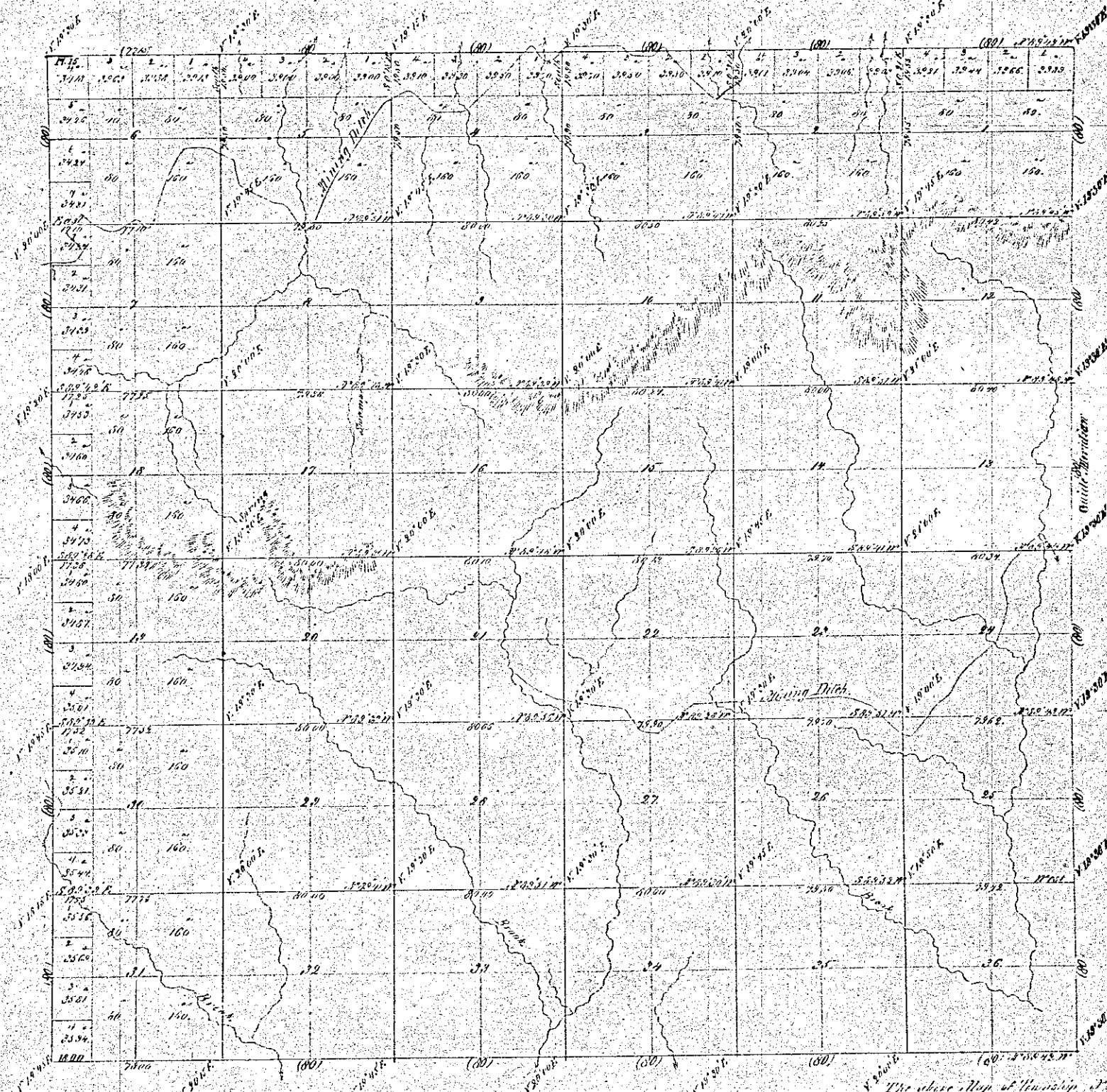

General Description.

This Township lies upon the dividing ridge between Barnes River and Willamette Creek and consists generally of rolling hills. It is well watered by numerous Brooks, the majority of which run south into Barnes Creek, the remainder north into Barnes River. Excellent Pine Fir and Hemlock timber grows in almost all of the basins. Good bunchgrass grows abundantly all over the Township. The Eldorado Mining Ditch carrying about 500 inches of water runs through the North-Western part of the Township from S.W. 1/4 to N.E. 1/4.
