

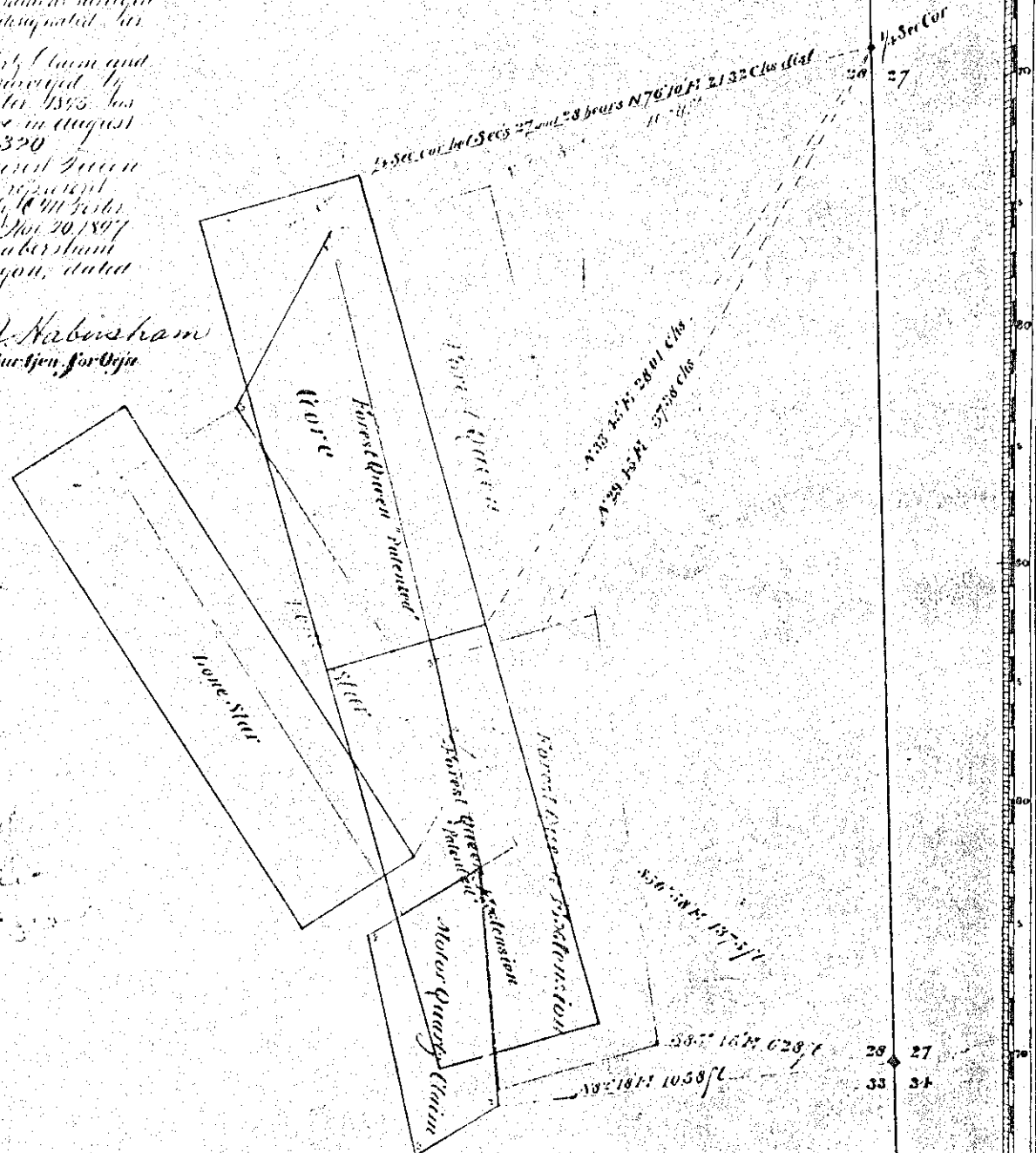
**Note.**

The claims marked *Forest Queen*, *Forest Queen & Extension*, *Forest Queen* & *Forest Queen* were patented in August 1890 designated as Mineral Survey No 319. The claims marked *Motor Quartz Claim* and *Yore Star* were said claims as surveyed by Arthur Plattner, under Mineral Survey No 309 and Yore in August 1896 as Mineral Survey No 320.

The red lines and names *Forest Queen* and *Forest Queen & Extension* represent the examination of the same by C. M. Fisher, under his official return dated Nov 20, 1897 under instructions of Robert C. Habersham, U.S. Surveyor General for Oregon, dated July 17, 1897.
