Property tax offset allocated to Baker County from revenues of Personal Income and Corporate Excise Taxes is \$468,699.80. Offset in mills computed upon total county assessed valuation is 19.99 mills. The amount of the property tax offset represents the amount of revenue which would be required to be raised in Baker County for State purposes, but which is provided by the Personal Income and Corporate Excise Tax Receipts.
