DIRECTIONS FOR COMPUTING YOUR TAX
The above schedule may be used to compute the proportion of tax paid to the various levying bodies included under the Code number shown on your tax statement. Computation may be made by multiplying the valuation shown on the statement by the millage levy as shown opposite the name of each levying body in each particular Code. One mill represents 1/10th of a cent, so in order to express mills in terms of dollars the decimal point in the millage rate has to be moved 3 places to the left.

By Act of the 1965 Legislature \$18,285,083 has been distributed to Oregon counties from the Local Property Tax Relief Account, as relief for local property taxes. \$275,688 has been distributed to Baker County for local
