By Act of the 1965 Legislature
\$16,700,487 have been distributed by the state as relief for local property taxes, reducing your tax rate by \$1.06 per thousand dollars of assessed value. As a result, the County tax rate has been reduced from \$3.19 to 2.13. This county received \$209,982 from the state for this purpose.

In addition, the state has also provided \$25,950.65 for inventory tax relief and \$19,804.55 for senior citizens property tax relief in this county.

INSTRUCTIONS: for determining the portion of your tax that will be distributed to each of the taxing districts in which your property is located.

1. Find the assessed value of your property on your tax statement and convert it from dollars to thousands of dollars by placing a decimal point three places from the right. Example: 8000 becomes 8.000 thousand.

2. Find the code area number on your tax statement. Refer to the same number in the listing above and obtain the tax rate for each taxing district shown.

3. Multiply the value (in thousands) by each district's tax rate. The answer is the amount of money that each district will receive.

EXAMPLE: If your Code Number is 5-1 and the taxable value is \$8,000, your breakdown would be as follows:
