SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, James D. Hanley certify that I have correctly surveyed and prepared this minor partition plat in accordance with O.R.S. Chapter 92. The land partition is described as follows:

In Township 7 South, Range 38 East Section 36: The West half of the Southwest quarter, except Baker County Road No. (711) 1138 right of way, the boundaries of which are more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Baker County road, N. 0° 07' 50" W., 30.00 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 36; thence N. 0° 07' 50" W., 2622.97' feet to the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter said Section 36; thence N. 89° 50' 27" E., 1321.25' feet to the Northeast corner of the West half of the Southwest quarter; thence S. 0° 11' 21" E., 2623.67' feet along the East line of the West half of the Southwest quarter to the North line of said Baker County road; thence S. 89° 52' 18" W., along said North line a distance of 1323.94 feet to the point of beginning.

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this plat for the Marian Jacobson Trust is to partition the West half of the Southwest quarter into two parcels in accordance with ORS Chapter 92. The subdivision of Section 36, based on original surveys of 1864 and 1882 was retraced according to BLM Manual of Instructions for Survey of the Public Lands. Monumentation for the Southeast corner of Section 36 and the South quarter corner of Section 34 was recovered as recorded in Baker County Survey No. 8-38-22. That survey proportionately relocated the intervening section and quarter section corners along the township line lying in the county road right of way. Original corner monumentation marking Section 36 consisted of wood posts, now gone, and in some instances perpetuated by construction of fence lines outlining the original survey. Deed 84-19-050 identifies the property being partitioned.

DECLARATION

Know all people by these presents that the Marian Jacobson Trust is owner of the land represented on the annexed map, and more particularly described in the accompanying Surveyor's Certificate, and that John L. Jacobson, trustee for the Marian Jacobson Trust has caused this land to be surveyed and partitioned into two parcels as shown.

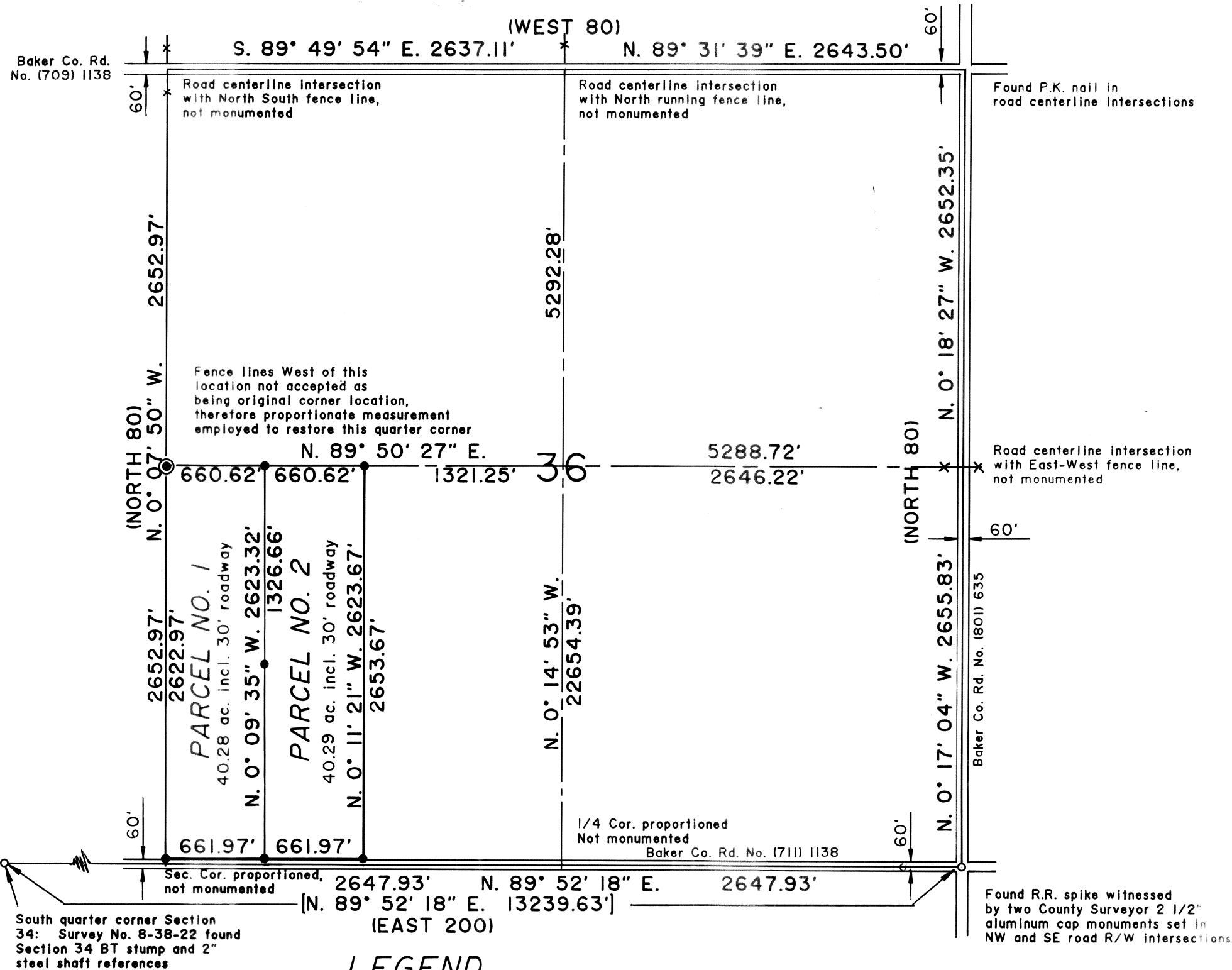
