


SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, James D. Hanley, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land represented on the annexed minor partition map, the boundaries being described as follows:

A tract of land in the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 8 South, Range 38

East, Willamette Meridian, County of Baker, State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 25, S. 00°23'12"E., 775.00 feet from the Northeast Corner of said section; thence S. 00°23'12"E. along said East line III6.66 feet; thence S. 89°45'48"W., 1209.57 feet; thence N. 00°10'12"W., 1113.93 feet; thence N. 89°38'03"E., 1205.36 feet; to the Point of Beginning.



NARRATIVE

RENEWAL DATE JAN. 1, 1996

The purpose of this survey and partition plat for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America Foundation is to partition a tract of land previously described in Deed 93-51-043 as Parcel No. 3 of Partition Plat Pl992-006 into three parcels. Monumentation previously established from Baker County Surveys No. 8-38-18, 19, 49, 50, 53 and 56 (Partition Plat Pl992-006) was recovered including the North Line of the NEI/4 of Section 25. This line which bears N. 89° 38′ 03″E. is held as the basis of this survey traverse. Deeds 89-10-019, 88-36-063 and 93-51-043 are compatible with the above referenced surveys. This survey was performed according to accepted land survey practices and O.R.S. Chapter 92.

DECLARATION


