I, Jack L. Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, Parcels 1 and 2 in accordance with the statutes of the State of Oregon and that Parcel 3 was not surveyed during this partition process. This partition is situated in the NW1/4 of Section 32, T9S, R37E, W.M., City of Sumpter, Baker County, Oregon.

CERTIFICATE

The deed calls for the westerly line of the dredge area and gives courses along the line. I could not locate the survey which located the dredge area and produced the courses. Information from the Baker County Surveyor leads me to believe that Art Woodwell, a surveyor from the early 1900's, produced these courses which the deeds have used. I held the deed record bearing and distances and the point on the westerly line of the dredge area described in deed Book 175, Page 133 which is North 1225 feet from the SE corner of the NE1/4SW1/4 of Section 32. The new division lines were established at the locations chosen by Mr.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments shown hereon. Baker County Survey No. 9-37-11 shows the establishing of the C1/4 corner of Section 32. Survey No. 9-37-46 dated June 1980, is a further subdivision of Section 32, although a different position was established for the C1/4 corner of Section 32. Survey No. 9-37-46 was performed for the Forest Service in order to identify the National Forest Lands in Section 32. The narrative is a little vague in regard to the procedure used to establish the E1/4 corner and the SE corner of this section. I accept the monuments shown from Survey No. 9-37-46 for the subdivision of this section because of the adjoining National Forest Land.
