

**ENGINEER'S STATEMENT AND PROPERTY DESCRIPTION**

I, James D. Hanley, being first duly sworn, say that I have correctly surveyed and plotted the lands represented by the accompanying plat of Baker Industries and Resources Corporation, the exterior boundaries of which are described as follows: Beginning at the SE corner of Section 20, T 9 S., R. 40 E., W.M., running thence North 1268 feet; thence West to the East right of way line of the Sumpter Valley Railway Company; thence southerly along said right of way to a point 660 feet North of the South line of said SE 1/4 SE 1/4; thence West to a point 330 feet West of the East line of said SE 1/4 SE 1/4; thence South 660 feet to the South line of said SE 1/4 SE 1/4; thence East 330 feet to the place of beginning. Also, beginning at the Southeast corner of the said Section 20; thence N. 89° 49' W., 330 feet; thence S. 0° 31' W., 244 feet; thence N. 89° 49' W., 180 feet; thence S. 0° 31' W., 177 feet; thence N. 89° 54' 30" W., 1322.07 feet to a point on the East line of an old county road; thence along said county road: S. 28° 25' E., 495.26 feet; thence S. 51° 36' E., 84.19 feet; thence S. 59° 46' E., 1600.12 feet; thence S. 35° 40' 30" E., 224.15 feet; thence S. 36° 02' E., 349.57 feet; thence S. 09° 15' E., 335.62 feet to a point on the West bank of Powder River; thence northerly along the said West bank to the North line of Section 28; thence N. 89° 49' 30" W., 401.65 feet to the point of beginning. Excepting Baker-Unity State Highway right of way lying within the above described subdivision boundary. And also excepting the parcel designated Tract 1.

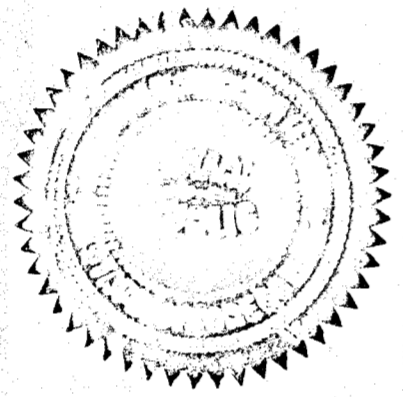
