Haskell, Louis Sommer and Herman Fuchs, in consideration of the privileges, rights and advantages to be derived therefrom hereby make, create and file of record that certain map hereto attached and hereby made a part of this instrument, the same being a map of the "Haskell Addition" to Baker City, and covering a part of the South East Quarter of Section (16) Sixteen Township (9) Nine South, Range (40) Forty East of Willamette Meridian, bounded as follows: From a point 424.6 feet South of the N. E. Corner of N. W. Quarter of South East Quarter of Section 16 T. 9 S. R. 40 E. the point of beginning, running South 895.5 feet to the North line of the Pacific Addition to Baker City, thence West 1333.8 feet, thence north along the line of the old Lindayson fence 892 feet, thence East 1331.2 feet to point of beginning, and we hereby dedicate for the public use those certain streets and alleys marked and located in the said map.
