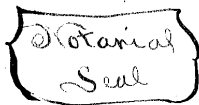

In consideration of the sum of one Dollar to them in hand paid do hereby lay our said land into Blocks, lots, Streets, Gallies as shown on said plat and do also hereby dedicate to public use all that part of said lands as are represented on said plat as Streets and Alleys to the full extent and dimensions thereof as represented on said plat.
