


The said Streets along the line of the Railroad being thirty feet in width and otherwise being sixty feet in width and said Alleys being fifteen feet in width and said Addition consisting of that portion of Block 3. 2. 14. 15. 18. 19. 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> as designated on said plat and each party hereto hereby dedicating that portion thereof owned by him as designated all in S. E. 1/4 Sec 7. T. 9. S. R. 40 & N. M.
