

The Town of McEwen, is situated upon the following described lands, lying and being in the County of Baker and State of Oregon, to-wit: The West half of the North East quarter and the East half of the South West quarter of Section Eighteen in Township Ten South of Range No Thirty Eight East of the Willamette Meridian, according to the United States Government Survey thereof.

Now therefore, know all men by these presents, that I, Thomas M. Ewen an unmarried man, the owner and proprietor of the land, above described, upon which the town of McEwen is situated, have, and by these presents do cause the same to be laid out in accordance with the annexed plat, in said town of McEwen, and dedicate for the public use forever all streets and alleys as thereon shown, saving and excepting therefrom all that portion of said land heretofore deeded by me to the Swinpton Valley Paving Company for right of way, by deed of Warranty dated September 28th, 1891, the said excepted portion being more particularly described in said deed. All streets and Alleys in said town of McEwen are of the width indicated on said plat, and all lots are of the length and width indicated thereon.
