Sally and Josephine Sally his wife of the County of Baker and State of Oregon, owners and holders of the legal title to all and singular the lands by us laid out and platted as Sally's Addition to Baker City in the said County and State and situated in the East half of the North East quarter of Section Number nine Township Nine South of Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, do hereby ^{for the consideration of the sum of \$200 to the said land} dedicate to public use all that portion of the land so platted and represented upon said plat as streets and alleys to the full extent hereof as shown upon said plat, save and except always the streets and alleys between Maxwell and York and Grace and Estes Streets. (Said George H. Sally is the same person whose name is sometimes spelled George H. Salley).

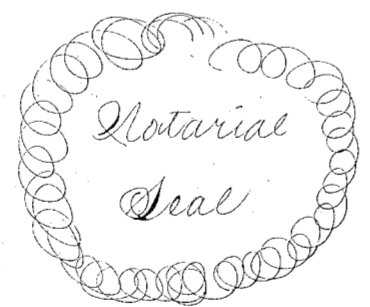
