I, Henry L. Melton being duly sworn to testify and say that I have correctly surveyed and platted the land as represented by the accompanying plat, the exterior boundaries of which are described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin monument at the intersection of the east line of Dewey Avenue and the south line of Myrtle Street, said initial point being South 59°28'E, thirty-seven and one-half feet (37.5) and South 30°20' west, thirty (30.0) feet from the iron monument at the intersection of the centre lines of Dewey Avenue and Myrtle streets and is the Northwest corner of the Tract hereafter to be known as Stoddard's Addition to the City of Baker, Oregon. Thence, S. 59°28'E, along the south line of Myrtle street one hundred sixty five (165.0) feet to a 1" iron monument which is the N.E. Corner of the above mentioned tract, thence; S. 30°20'W, two hundred eighty-three and fifty-seven hundredths (283.57) feet to the intersection of the North line of the Union Pacific Railroad Right of Way, which is the S.E. Corner of the above mentioned Tract, Thence; N. 58°40'W, along the north line of the U.P.R.R. Right of Way one hundred sixty five and six one-hundredths (165.06) feet to a 1" iron pin at the intersection of the east line of Dewey Avenue which is the Southwest corner of a 1/16 of Grier's Addition Thence; N. 30°20'E, along the east line of Dewey Avenue two hundred seventy-nine and nine-tenths (279.9) feet to the point of beginning. Said Tract being a part of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section twenty (20) Township nine (9) South, Range forty (40) East of the Willamette Meridian of Oregon, and the said Tract being <sup>the same as described in plat and map 165 of 1941</sup> <sup>the same as described in plat and map 165 of 1941</sup> of Grier's Addition to the City of Baker, Oregon lying south of Myrtle Street, and that I marked on the ground with proper monuments, the subdivision as represented, by monumenting and staking the boundaries as indicated and placing iron pins as above stated.
