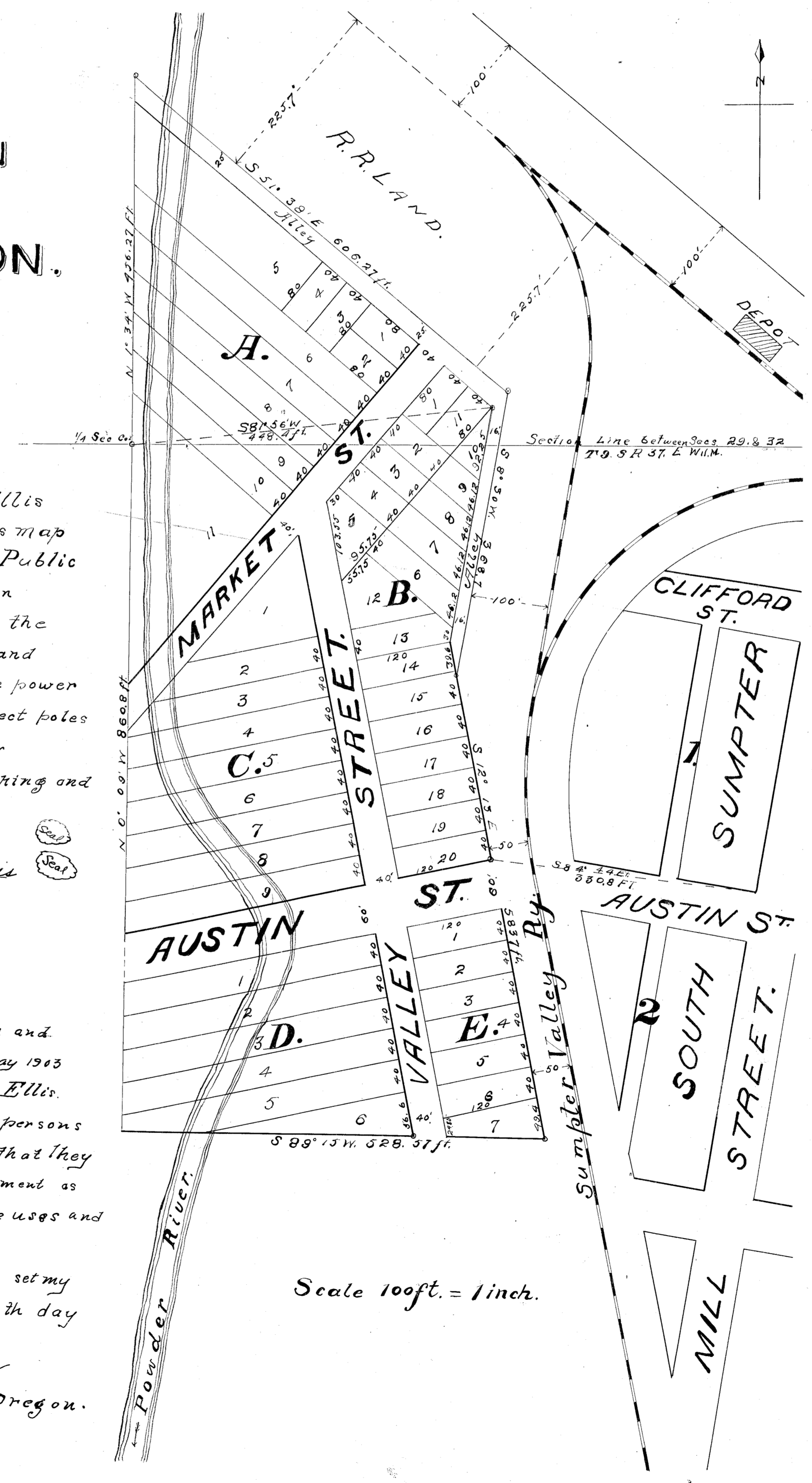
Dedication
Know all men by these presents:
That A.W. Ellis
and Maud Ellis do hereby declare this map
and do hereby dedicate to the use of the Public
forever, all the Streets and alleys thereon
excepting all timber therein and reserving the
exclusive right to lay down Railways therein, and
propel cars thereon by steam or other motive power
to lay down pipes and wires thereon to erect poles
and extend wires thereon for the purposes of
conducting electricity, for telephoning, telegraphing and
electric lights.
