I hereby certify to be correct, the survey & plat herewith, of Gellatly's Addition to the Town of Sumpter, Baker County, Oregon, being a subdivision of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 28, T. 9 S. R. 37 E. - 4th M. More particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Initial Point (I.P.) identical with the 1/4 corner common to Sections 28-33. thence along section line between Secs. 28 & 33, N. 89° 34' W. 1328.4 feet to a stake on the East boundary of the Sumpter Townsite Syndicate's First Addition to the town of Sumpter, thence along said East boundary N. 0° 18' 14" 1310.4 feet to a stake on said boundary, thence S. 89° 26' E. 1326.9 feet to a stake on the center line of Sec. 28, thence along said center line, S. 0° 21' E. 1307.3 ft. to the place of beginning. Containing 34.89 acres. The dimensions of the lots, blocks, streets & alleys are as shown on this plat.
