

I, James D. Hanley, certify that I have correctly surveyed and platted the parcel of land on the annexed map in accordance with O.R.S. Chapter 92, the exterior boundary of which is

Beginning at the Northwest intersection of Ash and Ibex Streets which is the Southeast corner of Block I, Mill Addition to Sumpter, Oregon; thence N.81° 44'W., I50 feet along the Northerly line of Ash Street to the Easterly line of a 20 foot wide alley; thence N.O8\* 16'E., 100 feet along said alley; thence S.81\* 44'E., 150 feet to the Westerly line of Ibex Street; thence S.08° 16'W., 100 feet along lbex Street right of way to the point of beginning.

### NARRATIVE

In the NEI/4 of Section 32, T. 9 S., R. 37 E., W.M., in Sumpter, Oregon:

This survey for Lois Julian is for the purpose of marking on the ground the North 10 feet of Lots 12, 13, and 14, Block I, Mill Addition for a boundary line adjustment, and also equally dividing the remainder of the three subject lots into two parts, a replat of the original configuration.

Mill, Columbia, Bonanza, and Ibex Streets are parallel; their centerlines bear N. 08° 16′ E. All Sumpter surveys are referenced to the "Woodwell Base Line", consisting of two nails in Mill Street, Il feet Easterly of street centerline. The Southernmost point on the base line is N. 81° 44′ W., 19 feet from the Southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 4, South Sumpter Ellis Addition (basis of bearing of this subject survey) and intersecting streets bear S. 81° 44′ E. Monuments set consist of 5/8 inch x 30 inch rebars with plastic caps marked "HANLEY ENGR PLS 1206". A railroad spike was found marking the intersection of Austin and Ibex Street centerlines. The intersection of Austin Street and Ibex Street centerlines is S. 08° 16′ W., 30 feet and S. 81° 44′ E., 1059 feet from the South Woodwell nail. Layout of subject property proceeded from this data.
