Surveyor's Certificate.

I hereby certify to be correct, the Survey and Plat herewith, of St. Louis Addition to the town of Sumpter, Baker County, Oregon, being a subdivision of a portion of Sec. 32, T. 9 S. R. 27 E. W. 4. More particularly described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at the Initial Point (P) identical with the S.W. corner of Block 28 of the Sumpter Townsite Syndicate's First Addition to the town of Sumpter, thence along the East line of Beech Street, S. 2° 15' W. 2879.9 ft, thence S. 89° 5' W. 76.6 ft, thence N. 0° 4' E. 124.7 ft to the line through the center of Sec. 32, thence the 1/2 cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 bears N. 84° 45' E. 1331.4 ft, thence N. 0° 4' W. 1345.6 ft to the South line of Ash Street, if produced, thence S. 81° 44' E. 12.9 ft to S.V.R.R. Right of way, thence along said R. of W. S. 16° 44' E. 214.5 ft, thence N. 81° 44' E. 104 ft thence along R. of W. N. 18° 44' W. 289.7 ft to the North line of Ash Street, thence along said North line of Ash Street S. 81° 44' E. 412.3 ft to the place of beginning.
