Know All Men By These Presents, That We, Arthur W. Ellis and Maudie Ellis, his wife, do hereby declare this Map, and do hereby dedicate to the use of the Public, forever, all the Avenues, Streets, Alleys, Highways and Parks thereon, excepting all Minerals therein contained, and all timber thereon and reserving the exclusive right to lay down Railways thereon, and propel cars thereon, by steam or other motive power, to lay down pipes and wires thereon, to erect poles and extend wires thereon, for the purposes of conducting Electricity for telephoning, telegraphing and electric lights.
