"DEDICATION."

Know all men by these presents, That the Sumpter Lumber Company do hereby declare this map and do hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever, all the Avenues, Streets, Alleys and highways thereon, excepting all minerals therein contained, and reserving the exclusive right to lay down Railways therein, and propel cars thereon by steam or other motive power, to lay down pipes and wires therein, to erect poles and extend wires thereon for the purpose of conducting electricity, for telephoning, telegraphing and electric lights.
