

Field notes of the survey of Usher's West addition to the town of Richland, in Baker Co., Oregon.
 Beginning at the S.W. corner to Lot Ten 1107 in Usher's South add., thence North 745 ft. thence West 75 ft. thence ^{South} 150 ft. thence following the meanders of an irrigating ditch in a southerly direction to a point West, thence South 115 ft., thence East 83.5 ft., thence North 115 ft. to the place of beginning. Lot No 1 is 115 ft. N. and S. by 93.5 ft. E. & W. Lots 2-3 & 4 are 75 ft. front on 3d St. extending West to an intersection with the aforesaid irrigation ditch. Lot 5 is 60 ft. front, extending W. to irrigation ditch, the private lane is 10 ft. front, ^{extending W. to irrigation ditch.} Lots 6, 7, 8 & 9 are 75 ft. front, extending W. to irrigation ditch. Lots 10 & 11 are 75 ft. front by 75 ft. deep.
