

Know All Men By These Presents: That We, John W. F. Volker and Edith Volker, husband and wife, do hereby declare that the annexed map is a true and correct map of the Townsite of Whitney, in the County of Baker, State of Oregon, and that we are the owners in fee simple of the South half of the Southeast quarter of section twenty-eight (28), and the South west quarter of Section twenty-seven (27), and the northwest quarter of Section thirty-four (34), all in Township ten (10) South of Range thirty-six (36) E. N. M., being the land upon which said townsite is situated.

And we do hereby forever dedicate to the public all the streets, roads, avenues and alleys as designated upon said map and shown thereby, specially reserving from said dedication that portion of said map lying South of Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 9 as shown upon the map, being the portion lying between said blocks and the Dumfries Valley Railway Company's railroad track as stated out upon said ground, said ground belonging exclusively to the Dumfries Valley Railway Company.
