
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was orginally established by W. B. Barr, under G. L. O. contract No. 388, in September, Surveyors General's notes state; "Marked fir 18 in. diam. for 1/4 sec. corner from which a Fir 14 in. diam. bears N5°W, 5 lks. dist., a Fir 14 in. diam. bears S73°E, 38 lks. dist."



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 24" white fir snag scribed "1/4 S" on west face. white fir snag scribed "1/4 S BT" bears N5°W, 3.2 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

W.C. 6FT NO. Unable to set pipe at snag, measured North 6.0 ft. from center of snag and set Witness Corner for 1/4 section corner. Set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe T6SR38E [S19 and brass cap marked: T_{W1/4} Set pipe 25" in the ground and mound of stone OR PLS 1051 around to cap. 1979 From which: by magnetic declination of N20°E; A 15" tamarac bears N76°E, 37.5 ft. scribed W. C. 1/4S19 BT. A 9" tamarac bears S22°W, 17.7 ft. scribed W. C. T6SR37E BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-5on old BT. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' North of corner.
