No myidence of original bearing trees found, as they have also been destroyed by the fence trail.

Position set by Proportionate measurement conforms to call to the Creek 2.10 Ch. west. Therefore accepted the proportion position as the 1/4 Cor.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

But 2-1/2" aluminum pipe with 2-1/2" aluminum cap stamped as shown on the Diagram, set 14" in the ground and raised a mound of stone and earth around the pipe. Corner is at the base of an earth cut place in fencing trail.
