HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:


Corner originally established by Timothy W. Davenport under GLO contract number 102, dated July 20, 1863. Surveyor General records states:

Found no evidence of the GLO Corner monument or accessories.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At a position determined by survey, I set a 2 ½"x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which;

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:


A 5/8"x30" iron pin with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP" bears North $83^{\circ}20$ ' East, a distance of 25.27 feet.


A 5/8"x30" iron pin with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP" bears South $46^{\circ}47$ ' East, a distance of 40.34 feet. (On South bank of irrigation ditch)

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP" bears South $41^{\circ}18$ ' West, a distance of 34.56 feet. (On South bank of irrigation ditch)

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with $1\frac{1}{2}"$ aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER'NW RP" bears North 86°31! West, a distance of 39.13 feet.
