At a position determined by survey, I set a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which;

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP" bears North  $86^{\circ}11$ ' East, a distance of 3.89 feet. (In E-W Fence)

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP" bears South  $19^{\circ}46$ ' East, a distance of 18.11 feet. (On South bank of irrigation ditch)

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP" bears South  $64^{\circ}21$ ' West, a distance of 39.43 feet. (On South bank of irrigation ditch)


