
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner was originally established by W. B. Barr under Contract No. 503 in July, 1884. The original notes state that a 4' long × 4" diameter post was set 24" in ground from which:

A 6" Pine bears S 45° W 100 LKS marked 1/4 S BT. A 20" Pine bears S 40° E 45LKS marked 1/4 S BT.

No evidence of subsequent re-monumentation was found in County Records.



Description of corner evidence found:


None.

After a thorough search for the corner I set it by single proportion measure between the Southeast and Northeast corner of Section 27, both found corners.

Description of monument and accessories Lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner. At the calculated corner position I set a $2^n \times 30^n$ iron pipe with brass cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone marked:

From which:

A 23" Ponderosa Pine bears S 79° W for 29.5 feet, scribed 1/4 S27 BT. A 24" Ponderosa Pine bears S $76\frac{1}{2}$ ° E for 34.7 feet, scribed 1/4 S26 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted red ring around each BT. Set steel fence post with sign 54-9 attached next to monument.

Used magnetic compass with 20^{10}_2 E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
