
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.




Description of corner evidence found:

None.

*A 6' tall iron rod bears S 80° E for 5.6 feet set by property owner.

Description of manument and accessories Lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Set 2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked: Set monument 6" in ground to solid rock and surrounded with a mound of stone to within 6" of cap from which:

A 24" Ponderosa Pine bears N $13\frac{1}{2}$ ° E for 16.3 feet, scribed S 1/16 S27 BT. An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears N 74° W for 57.2 feet, scribed S 1/16 S28 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT. Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Used magnetic compass with $20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
