
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:



Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position I set a 2" \times 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 24" in ground and surrounded with mound of stone to cap from which:

A 28" Tamarack bears S $83\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 67.7 feet, scribed E-E 1/64 S34 BT. A 17" Red Fir bears N 2° W for 46.3 feet, scribed E-E 1/64 S27 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT.



Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Witness: Les Wilson

Used magnetic compass with $20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
