
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by RPE 2808 in ocroser 1972 (1/2" iron pin with plastic cap marked RPE 2808)




Description of corner evidence found:

1/2" iron pin with plastic cap marked RPE 2808.
The pin position bears N 53 35 w for 1.55 feet from our calculated position.

Description of monument and accessories l'established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. At the position of the 1/2" iron pin I set a 2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 24" in ground and leveled a 3 foot flat spot around monument. Buried pin underground next to monument.

A  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Spruce bears S  $22\frac{1}{2}$ ° E for 12.0 feet, scribed W-W 1/64 S34 BT. A 17" White Fir bears N  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 19.7 feet, scribed W-W 1/64 S27 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT. Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Used magnetic compass with  $20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
