

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position 1 set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:


Set monument 20" in ground and surrounded with mound of stones from which:

A 7½" Red Fir bears N 47° E for 3.4 feet, scribed C-S-N 1/64 S28 BT.

An 8" Red Fir bears N 59° W for 24.3 feet, scribed C-S-N 1/64 S28 BT.

BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around BT's.

Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.
