
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.




Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories l'established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 20" in ground with mound of stone from which: An 11" Red Fir bears N $45\frac{1}{4}$ ° W for 9.3 feet, scribed C-E 1/16 S28 BT. A 9" Bull Pine bears S 73-3/4° E for 46.6 feet, scribed C-E 1/16 S28 BT. BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54=3 and painted a red ring around BT's. Set steel fence post on property line near monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Used magnetic compass with $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
