
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.




Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories Lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 24" in ground with mound of stones to cap from which: A 14" Red Fir bears N $70\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W for 22.8 feet, scribed C-E-W 1/64 S28 BT. A 22" Red Fir bears $89\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W for 52.5 feet, scribed C-E-W 1/64 S28 BT. BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around BT's. Set steel fence post on property line near monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.
