
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.




Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories Lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the calculated corner positon I set a 2" \times 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 15" in ground and surrounded with mound of stone from which: A $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Red Fir bears S 6° E for 23.0 feet, scribed SE-SE 1/64 S28 BT. A 26" White Fir bears S 73° W for 45.0 feet, scribed SE-SE 1/64 S28 BT. BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around BT's. Set steel fence post on property line near monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.
