
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 28" in ground and leveled flat spot around it from which: A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears N $15\frac{1}{2}$ ° E for 21.2 feet, scribed NW-NW 1/64 S35 BT. A $25\frac{1}{2}$ " Ponderosa Pine bears S 48° E for 63.0 feet, scribed NW-NW 1/64 S35 BT.

BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around BT's.

Set steel fence post on property line near monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Witness: Les Wilson Gene Salter

Used magnetic compass with $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
