
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 20" in ground and surrounded with mound of stone to within 1" of cap from which:

A 10" White Fir bears N $37\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 4.1 feet, scribed C-W-NW 1/64 S35 BT. A 14" Red Fir bears N 37° E for 11.2 feet, scribed C-W-NW 1/64 S35 BT. BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around BT's.

Set steel fence post on property line near monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.
