
History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position 1 set a 2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 24" in ground and surrounded with mound of stones to cap from which:

An 11" Red Fir bears S $56\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 8.6 feet, scribed C-N-SW 1/64 S35 BT. A 10" Red Fir bears N $12\frac{1}{2}$ ° E for 23.0 feet, scribed C-N-SW 1/64 S35 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT.

Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Witness: Les Wilson

Used magnetic compass with $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
