
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories Lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the calculated corner position I set a  $2" \times 30"$  iron pipe with brass cap marked:


Set monument 6" below road surface from which:

A 13" Ponderosa Pine bears N 66½° W for 138.7 feet, scribed N 1/16 S34 BT A 16" Red Fir bears S 20° E for 61.1 feet, scribed N 1/16 S35 BT.

Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped

Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT.

Set a steel fence post on section line by monument and attached sign 54-9.

Used magnetic compass with  $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
